Fortunately, you have all the material for this course. I will just tell you what you need to study and the subtitles or questions for each chapter of the book.

As for Chapter 14 entitled “*The Old Man and the Sea* – Critical Summary,” you will have multiple choice questions about the events of the novel and their analysis. You will not have essay questions about this chapter.

As for Chapter 15 entitled “Santiago’s Fight with the Marlin and his Battle with the Sharks,” you can have an essay question. You can summarize this chapter in 2-3 pages.

If you have an essay question about this chapter, you will include the following points in your answer:

- I. The three stages of Santiago’s fight with the marlin
- II. Santiago’s battle with the sharks:
  - 1. His state of exhaustion
  - 2. The arrival of the first shark
  - 3. The wounds on Santiago’s hands
  - 4. Killing the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> sharks
  - 5. The attacks by more sharks
  - 6. The symmetry about the story
